General information

St. Martin Parish Library Cardholders have many services available. They may check out books, DVD's, magazines, Audio CD's eBooks, large print books and computers. Our computers have Microsoft Software available to use. In addition to these materials, St. Martin Parish Library has a large genealogy collection and Louisiana room at the St. Martinville and Breaux Bridge locations. St. Martin Parish Library is a Wi-Fi hotspot and subscribes to many databases where students and teachers can access articles from magazines and journals as well as access to the St. Martin Parish Library card catalog. These databases are easily accessed from any computer with internet access using your library card number. St. Martin Parish Library offers interlibrary loans and outreach services to all patrons of St. Martin Parish.

Library Card Registration

Library cards are free to anyone with proof of residency of St. Martin Parish. A new applicant must show a government issued photo ID and proof of current address, school ID, pay stub or current bill. Juvenile cards are issued to those in second (2nd) through twelfth (12th) grade. The adult, parent or grandparent, is responsible for any fees or fines the juvenile incurs and is also responsible for the choice of materials the juvenile uses or borrows. Library staff does not censor selection.
