On Friday, November 17, 2023, St. Bernard School will hold its 5th Annual Crusader Challenge with a goal to raise \$55,000. In the past, this event has funded various campus improvements and curriculum enrichment materials and supplies. The next step in our facilities long range plan is to build a new dynamic playground in the center of our campus. Any Crusader Challenge financial support will help get us closer to reaching that goal.

This whole-school event requires students to walk or jog around a pre-set race course here on campus as many times as possible in a set time frame. Each student is encouraged to solicit funds by asking sponsors to contribute a tax deductible donation to St. Bernard School.

- On the home screen enter your event code: "crusaderchallenge" to locate your event
- Click "Not Registered For This Year's Event"

- Follow the instructions on-screen to register Challenger(s) and add family and friends

When you finish, the system emails pledge requests to your family and friends, and allows them to make secure credit card donations online. You get notified each time a pledge is made, and you can track your pledge progress online.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the Crusader Challenge?

The Crusader Challenge is a fundraiser where friends and family are donating whatever amount they choose in support of the student participating in a challenge, in our case, a race course. Donations are not determined by how fast the student completes the race or how many laps the student completes, but instead are fixed. The race is a fun way for all students to participate at a level they feel comfortable and fundraise for school/campus improvements. There are prize incentives to encourage friendly competition among the individual students and also between classes.

Why are we doing this school fundraiser?

The funds generated from the Crusader Challenge will be put towards campus improvements, such as future gym renovations and upgraded playground equipment, and continued curriculum development.

Who can participate?

All students will participate in the Crusader Challenge. Students in 5th - 8th grade who raise a minimum of \$200 will be given the opportunity to participate in the Sader Showdown.

How do you donate?

This year we are using an awesome web based fundraising system that makes it **much easier** for you to request pledges from your family and friends, and for them to make secure credit card donations online. It's fun, it's easy, and people who use it typically raise twice as much as those who don't! Each family will create their own page using the instructions sent home on **Tuesday**, **October 10**, **2023**. When will donations begin to be accepted?

Donations can be made beginning Wednesday, October 11, 2023.

What is the deadline for donations?

Donations can be accepted all year long. However, in order for donations to count towards a student's incentive level, donations must be turned in by <u>Friday, November 10, 2023 at 3 pm</u>. Any donations turned in after this time will not be put towards a student's incentives.

What are the students expected to do on race day?

On race day, students will walk, jog or run around the Crusader Circle, a designated area, as many times as possible during a set amount of time.

What is the schedule of events?

A schedule of events will be shared at a later date.

What if there is a chance of rain?

The committee will keep a close eye on the forecast the week of the race. If there is a chance of rain that seems like it will affect the race, the event will be moved up to <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>November 15</u>, <u>2023</u>. Parents will be notified of the change.

Is there a theme for the event?

The theme for this year's Crusader Challenge is "Loose in Louisiana". More details to come.

What is the Sader Showdown?

The Sader Showdown is a competition between 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th grade students who raise a minimum of \$200 in donations. These students compete through the race course with an added military style obstacle course. Each student is allowed one lap through the course. The Student with the fastest time will win.
