Please note the guidelines below, which can be found in the Parent / Student Handbook:

### **Free Dress Day Attire**

Special days are designed throughout the year by administration as "Free Dress Days". Students are free to wear outfits of their choice; however, the following guidelines must be followed. All shirts must have a sleeve. The stomach area may not be exposed. There can be no advertisements or logos with inappropriate messages or pictures. Shorts must not be shorter than three (3) inches above the knee from a kneeling position and dresses and skirts must not be shorter than one (1) inch above the knee from a kneeling position. No tight fitting clothes. Sandals are permitted. **Due to insurance liability and fire code regulations flip-flops and "Heelys" are NEVER ALLOWED**. Caps are not permitted. Capri pants are allowed. Clothing should be modest and not tight fitting. Parents will be called to bring a complete St. Bernard School uniform if free dress day attire is inappropriate.


