The SBS Christian Formation Sub-Committee would like to share some simple, yet powerful ways to prepare your hearts for the coming of Jesus during the Advent Season. The Advent Season begins on Sunday, December 1st, 2024, and ends on Tuesday, December 24th, 2024.

- 1. ADVENT WREATH: Set up an advent wreath in your home. It can be as simple as a store-bought wreath with plain candles with purple and pink ribbons. To learn more about Advent and the prayers attached to it go to: https://hallow.com/blog/advent-candles-and-advent-wreaths/
 - 2. ADVENT CALENDAR: An Advent Calendar is a calendar that helps us count down the days to Christmas, typically starting on December 1st. You can fill an Advent Calendar with treats, notes, prayer cards, or small toys.
- 3. ADORATION CHAPEL: St. Bernard Adoration Chapel offers a special gift for spending time in prayer and meditation in the presence of Jesus. Set a goal to visit once a week during the Advent Season, whether it's for an hour or a short time (10 or 15 minutes). Visit with Jesus as a family.

ADVENT REFLECTIONS AND MEDITATIONS: Actively Engage with the spiritual meaning of the season, focusing on themes of hope, peace, love, and joy. You can read bible stories, sign up for daily reflections, or read a book.

- 4. PRAY A ROSARY: You can pray the rosary each day, or part of a mystery as a family. CELEBRATE THE SAINTS: December 6th marks the Feast of St. Nicholas and December 13th celebrates the Feast of St. Lucy. Share the stories of the saints with your family.
- 5. ORNAMENTS AND TOYS: Each week add a symbolic religious ornament to your tree, put out a nativity, and/or donate by cleaning out used toys.
