Friday, April 11 th	3:15 p.m. – until	Final Tryout – Gym (Mandatory)

For Thursday, April 10th Practice: We will go over the cheer and dance with you as well as give more guidance on the other aspects of the tryouts such as the Spiriting, Jumps, etc. You must attend this practice ALREADY knowing the cheer and dance. All participants will need to wear comfortable clothing, socks and tennis shoes, and hair **MUST** be up in a ponytail. Girls are to bring their own water bottles for practice. NO PARENTS, GUESTS, etc. WILL BE ALLOWED TO WATCH THIS PRACTICE.

For Friday, April 11th Tryout: All Candidates **MUST** Wear Appropriate Athletic Clothing and Footwear (T-Shirts, Shorts, Sneakers, etc.) The shirt must be white and the shorts must be black. Hair **MUST** be secured in a Ponytail and Out of Your Eyes. More specific tryout information will be sent directly to each participant once the date gets closer.

NOTE: There will be no other tryout dates scheduled.

Please Note: All students who earn a spot on the 2025 – 2026 Cheerleading Squad are REQUIRED to attend cheer camp this summer with us as a squad from June 2 – 5, 2025 at the Crown Plaza in Baton Rouge.

Also Note: Cheerleading has an annual cost of about \$850 - \$975.

(The exact cost has not been determined yet, but will be known by the parent meeting held after tryouts).

NOTE: Selecting a cheer squad is a very difficult decision and reality is...not every girl will make the squad. Make sure to come to practice on the 10th knowing the cheer and dance. The purpose of this practice session is not to begin teaching them to you, but to give you pointers.
