# St. Bernard School Summer 2025 Academic Requirements



**READING:** For all students entering 1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> Grade in August 2025.

## Goals of Summer Reading:

- Advance literacy and academic performance by engaging children and teens in reading.
- Foster a love of reading.
- Increase successful reading experiences through librarian-supported, self-selected, voluntary reading.
- Involve parents and all family members in the summer reading experience.
- Improve children's access to reading materials, which will encourage them to become readers.

## Summer Reading for all students entering 1<sup>st</sup> Grade in August 2025:

- Summer Reading is not required, but if you are interested in your child participating in the Accelerated Reader Program (AR), please contact Mrs. Tolliver at ([rtolliver@sbscrusaders.com](mailto:rtolliver@sbscrusaders.com)) for more information.

## Summer Reading Requirements for all students entering 2<sup>nd</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> Grade in August 2025:

- Read three (3) or more books of your choice within your **Zone of Proximal Development (ZPD)** used during the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter. Please note AR will not allow a test to be taken outside of your ZPD.
- To receive credit, take an AR test on at least three (3) books from home and score a minimum of 80%. AR Summer Testing begins on June 2, 2025. **Summer testing will end on August 6, 2025.**
- Reminder: Students cannot take an AR test on a book they have previously tested.
- Students completing the summer reading requirement will be invited to the beginning of the year incentive activity.

## Summer Reading Requirements for all students entering 6<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> Grade in August 2025:

- The junior high summer reading requirement has been posted in Google Classroom by grade level titled *2025 Summer*. **The assignment is due on August 11, 2025.**

**MATH:** For all students entering 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade in August 2025.

- It is highly recommended that students work on *XtraMath* for a minimum of 50 minutes per week. Students can access *XtraMath* via the Google Classroom titled *2025 Summer*. Goals have been set for each grade level.

**MATH:** For all students entering 4<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> Grade in August 2025.

- Students entering 4<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade will be enrolled in *IXL Math*. Assignments are posted in Google Classroom titled *2025 Summer*. **Students must complete the 20 Day Summer Program.** Students will receive 1 point per day, totaling 20 points for the First Quarter in Math.

***HOURS OF OPERATION***

After-Care services are provided each school day from the close of school until 6:00 p.m. Staff members are employed only until 6:00 p.m. We request that parents respect the time of closure. A late fee of \$1 per minute will be assessed after 6:00 p.m.

When severe weather conditions or other emergency situation dictate the closure of school, the After-Care program is also closed. The After-Care program is closed during the school holidays.

***AFTER-CARE SNACKS***

Nutritious snacks and beverages are served daily from 3:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m. Please inform the Program Director of any food allergies.

***AFTER-CARE HOMEWORK***

Supervision is provided for students to complete homework. Parents should indicate their wishes regarding homework on the After-Care registration form. It is the student's responsibility to know his/her assignment(s) and to bring needed materials. It is also the parent's responsibility to check that all homework assignment(s) are completed. **After-Care staff do not have keys to unlock classroom doors if students forget items.**

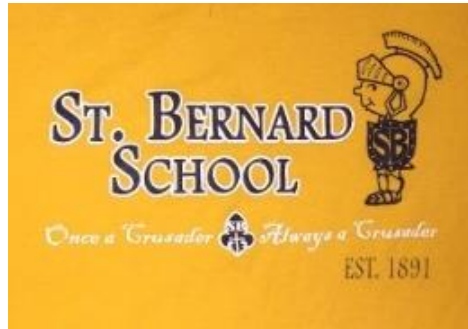

# SBS Mass Day Uniform Policy



## 2025 - 2026

**Shorts** are not allowed to be worn on St. Bernard School Mass days.

### **PreK3, PreK4, and Kindergarten - Mass Day Uniform**

- **GIRLS:**
  - Plaid Smock Dress (must touch the knee in front and back; see pictures below), or
  - Plaid jumper (must touch the knee in front and back; see pictures below) with gray knit pique polo shirt with school logo (no initials), or
  - Long navy uniform, pleated or flat front, pants that sit at the natural waist; with belt loops with gray knit pique polo shirt with school logo (no initials).
  - SBS plaid pull-on shorts, plaid bloomers, or navy or gray Softe shorts **MUST** be worn under smock dresses, jumpers and skirts.
- **BOYS:**
  - Long navy **uniform**, pleated or flat front, pants **WITHOUT** belt loops that sit at the natural waist; with gray pique knit polo shirt with school logo (no initials)

### **1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> Grade - Mass Day Uniform**

- **GIRLS:**
  - Plaid jumper or skirt (must touch the knee in front and back; see pictures below) with gray knit pique polo shirt with school logo (no initials).
  - Long navy uniform, pleated or flat front, pants that sit at the natural waist; with belt loops with gray knit pique polo shirt with school logo (no initials).
  - SBS plaid pull-on shorts, plaid bloomers, or navy or gray Softe shorts **MUST** be worn under smock dresses, jumpers and skirts.
- **BOYS:**
  - Long navy **uniform**, pleated or flat front, pants **WITH** belt loops that sit at the natural waist; with gray pique knit polo shirt with school logo (no initials)

### **Jr. High (6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> Grade) Mass Day Uniform**

- **GIRLS:**
  - Plaid jumper or skirt (must touch the knee in front and back; see pictures below) or
  - Long navy uniform, pleated or flat front, pants that sit at the natural waist; with belt loops;
  - White Oxford button down shirt with school logo on chest pocket; and
  - **See Shoe Policy in Uniform and Grooming Code**
- **BOYS:**
  - Long navy uniform, pleated or flat front, pants with belt loops that sit at the natural waist;
  - White Oxford button down shirt with school logo on chest pocket with SBS approved neck tie

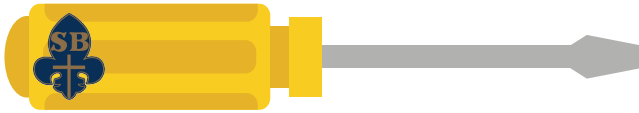

  - SBS plaid pull-on shorts, plaid bloomers, or navy or gray Softe shorts must be worn under smock dresses, jumpers and skirts.
- **1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> Grade**
  - Plaid jumper or skirt (must touch the knee in front and back; see pictures below) with gray knit pique polo shirt with school logo (no initials), or  
Plaid walking shorts (not shorter than three inches above the knee, measured from a kneeling position) with gray knit pique polo shirt with school logo (no initials), or  
Long navy uniform, pleated or flat front, pants that sit at the natural waist; with belt loops with gray knit pique polo shirt with school logo (no initials).
  - SBS plaid pull-on shorts, plaid bloomers, or navy or gray Softe shorts must be worn under smock dresses, jumpers and skirts.

## Mass Day Uniform

- **PreK3, PreK4, and K**
  - Plaid Smock Dress (must touch the knee in front and back; see pictures below), or Long navy uniform, pleated or flat front, pants that sit at the natural waist; without belt loops with gray knit pique polo shirt with school logo (no initials), or Plaid jumper (must touch the knee in front and back; see pictures below) with gray knit pique polo shirt with school logo (no initials).
  - SBS plaid pull-on shorts, plaid bloomers, or navy or gray Softe shorts must be worn under smock dresses, jumpers and skirts.
- **1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> Grade**
  - Plaid jumper or skirt (must touch the knee in front and back; see pictures below) with gray knit pique polo shirt with school logo (no initials), or Long navy uniform, pleated or flat front, pants that sit at the natural waist; with belt loops with gray knit pique polo shirt with school logo (no initials).
  - SBS plaid pull-on shorts, plaid bloomers, or navy or gray Softe shorts must be worn under smock dresses, jumpers and skirts.
- **Jr. High (6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> Grade)**
  - Plaid jumper or skirt (must touch the knee in front and back, see pictures below), or Long navy uniform, pleated or flat front, pants that sit at the natural waist; with belt loops;
  - White Oxford button down shirt with school logo on chest pocket

### **NOTES:**

Pants must be clean, hemmed, fitted and worn on the waist. **Excessively long, loose, tight or low rise/hip hugger pants are not acceptable.** Pants will not be accepted with brand logos, sequins, tears, rips, frayed ends, holes, etc. All pants that are faded must be replaced

### **Examples of acceptable length for Smock Dresses, Jumpers, and/or Skirts:**



All shirts **MUST** be tucked into pants, shorts, or skirts while on school campus. To help accomplish this, it is imperative students buy and wear shirts that are long enough to tuck in. The length of shirts should compensate for all bending, stretching, and squatting that the student may do during the day, and no skin or underwear should show at the waist when these activities are performed.

<b>JACKETS</b>	Plain, solid navy with official SBS logo (NO multi-colored or jean jackets allowed) Name brand logs are not permitted
<b>COATS</b>	Any colored heavy winter coat is acceptable for outdoors (NO denim or camouflage allowed)
<b>BLAZERS</b>	Plain, solid navy with SBS logo
<b>UNDERSHIRTS</b>	Plain, solid white or gray
<b>SOCKS</b>	Solid navy, black, or white – socks MUST COVER the ankle bone.
<b>TIGHTS/ STOCKINGS</b>	Navy or white only.
<b>HATS</b>	None Permitted.
<b>HOODS</b>	Hoods on all sweaters, sweatshirts, jackets and coats are permitted outdoors only.
<b>EARRINGS</b>	Simple stud earrings only. Only one piercing per ear is allowed. Hoop and dangling earrings are not only distracting to other students; they are also unsafe and not allowed.
<b>NECKLACES</b>	Small, simple religious medals, crosses, or scapulars on a silver or gold chain are allowed and must be worn inside the shirt. No chokers allowed at all. Only one necklace may be worn at any given time.
<b>BRACELETS</b>	One small, simple, metal religious bracelet is allowed. Bracelets can have such items as crosses, images of saints, Catholic devotional medals, etc.
<b>MAKE-UP</b>	None Permitted
<b>NAILS</b>	No artificial nails or nail polish permitted. Nails must be neat, clean and of appropriate length.
<b>BODY PIERCING</b>	None Permitted
<b>TATTOOS</b>	None Permitted
<b>*HAIR ACCESSORIES</b>	<b>All</b> bows, barrettes, ribbons, scrunchies, rubber bands, clips, headbands, etc. must be one or a combo of the following colors – <b>RED, WHITE, NAVY BLUE, YELLOW, OR GRAY</b> . Hair accessories made with the school's uniform plaid will also be permitted. <b>NO glitter or sequins allowed on bows.</b> <b>No other colored hair accessory will be allowed with the school's official uniform.</b>
<b>HAIR/STYLES/ COLOR</b>	Hair must be clean and neatly brushed or combed. Bangs must be at a length that does not extend below the eyebrows or they must be kept off of face by either a clip, headband or tucked behind the ears. Only natural colors and styles appropriate for school are acceptable.
<b>ADDITIONAL ITEM</b>	No sweaters, sweatshirts, jackets or coats can be worn around the waist inside any <u>building on campus</u> .

## BOYS

### Regular Uniform

- **PreK3, PreK4, and K**
  - Long navy **uniform**, pleated or flat front, pants **WITHOUT** belt loops that sit at the natural waist; with gray pique knit polo shirt with school logo (no initials), or  
Navy walking shorts that sit at the natural waist (not shorter than three inches above knee measured from a kneeling position) with belt loops; with gray pique knit polo shirt with school logo (no initials).
- **1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> Grade**
  - Long navy **uniform**, pleated or flat front, pants **WITH** belt loops that sit at the natural waist; with gray pique knit polo shirt with school logo (no initials), or  
Navy walking shorts that sit at the natural waist (not shorter than three inches above knee measured from a kneeling position) with belt loops; with gray pique knit polo shirt with school logo (no initials).

### Mass Day Uniform

- **PreK3, PreK4, and K**
  - Long navy **uniform**, pleated or flat front, pants **WITHOUT** belt loops that sit at the natural waist; with gray pique knit polo shirt with school logo (no initials).
- **1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> Grade**
  - Long navy **uniform**, pleated or flat front, pants **WITH** belt loops that sit at the natural waist; with gray pique knit polo shirt with school logo (no initials).
- **Jr. High (6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> Grade)**
  - Long navy **uniform**, pleated or flat front, pants **WITH** belt loops that sit at the natural waist, and
  - **White Oxford button down shirt with school logo on chest pocket with SBS approved neck tie**

#### NOTES:

Pants must be clean, hemmed, fitted and worn on the waist. **Excessively long, loose, tight or low rise/hip hugger pants are not acceptable.** Pants will not be accepted with brand logos, sequins, tears, rips, frayed ends, holes, etc. All pants that are faded must be replaced.

All shirts **MUST** be tucked into pants or shorts while on school campus. To help accomplish this, it is imperative students buy and wear shirts that are long enough to tuck in. The length of shirts should compensate for all bending, stretching, and squatting that the student may do during the day, and no skin or underwear should show at the waist when these activities are performed.

## ACCESSORIES

### SHOES

<b>PK – 5<sup>th</sup> Grade</b>	Any closed-toe shoe. No designs (i.e. polka dots, glitter, sequins, etc.) allowed. No boots, open toe, sandals, flip flops, heels, Crocs, light-up shoes or shoes with wheels. PreK and K must wear shoes with Velcro. Shoelaces must be solid and the same color as the shoe. Shoelaces must remain tied at all times.
<b>6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> Grade</b>	Tan (All Leather) or All White Athletic Tennis Shoe <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Styles - Topsider, Sperry or Magellan Brand only -Nike, Adidas, New Balance, etc.</li><li>• No “Converse” or “Vans” shoes are allowed; No “Hey Dude” shoes are allowed; No high top shoes are allowed</li></ul>

<b>COATS</b>	Any colored heavy winter coat is acceptable for outdoors (NO denim or camouflage)
<b>BLAZERS</b>	Plain, solid navy with SBS logo
<b>UNDERSHIRTS</b>	Plain, solid white or gray
<b>SOCKS</b>	<b>SOLID</b> navy, black, or white – socks <b>MUST COVER</b> the ankle bone.

<b>SHOES</b>	Any closed-toe shoe. No designs (i.e. polka dots, glitter, sequins, etc.) allowed. No boots, open toe, sandals, flip flops, heels, Crocs, light-up shoes or shoes with wheels. <b>PreK and K must wear shoes with Velcro.</b> Shoelaces must be solid and the same color as the shoe. Shoelaces must remain tied at all times. <b>JR. HIGH MASS DAY: ANY SOFT OR HARD SOLED DRESS SHOE</b>
<b>HATS</b>	None Permitted.
<b>HOODS</b>	Hoods on all sweaters, sweatshirts, jackets and coats are permitted outdoors only.
<b>EARRINGS</b>	None Permitted.
<b>NECKLACES</b>	Small, simple religious medals, crosses, or scapulars on a silver or gold chain is allowed and must be worn inside the shirt. No chokers allowed at all. Only one necklace may be worn at any given time.
<b>BRACELETS</b>	One small, simple, metal religious bracelet is allowed. Bracelets can have such items as crosses, images of saints, Catholic devotional medals, etc.
<b>NAILS</b>	Nails must be neat, clean and of appropriate length.
<b>BODY PIERCING</b>	None Permitted
<b>TATTOOS</b>	None Permitted
<b>HAIR/STYLES/ COLOR</b>	Hair and sideburns must be clean and neatly brushed or combed and should not go over the ear, below the eyebrow, or extend beyond the collar. Hair must be of a natural color. Fad haircuts and colors are contrary to the spirit of this dress and grooming code and; therefore, inappropriate. No facial hair, other than a reasonable sideburn is allowed. For this reason, students may be asked to shave.

### ***Spirit Shirt Fridays***

On Fridays, **ONLY**, students may wear any St. Bernard School sponsored T-shirt (Spirit, Athletic, Club, etc.) with uniform bottoms and shoes. All uniform policies listed above apply to the uniform bottoms and shoes. All grooming codes listed above continue to apply.

### ***Spirit Day Attire***

Special days are designated throughout the year by administration as “Spirit Days”. Students may wear any St. Bernard School sponsored T-shirt (Spirit, Athletic, Club, etc.) with long jeans, long tan khaki pants or school uniform bottoms. Pants must be clean, hemmed, fitted and worn on the waist. ***Excessively long, loose, tight or low rise/hip hugger pants are not acceptable.*** No pants will be accepted with sequins, tears, rips, frayed ends, holes, etc. Only regulation socks and shoes are permitted (see above descriptions). **Girls may wear hair accessories as listed above.** Parents will be called to bring a complete St. Bernard School uniform if spirit day attire is inappropriate. All grooming codes continue to apply.

### ***Free Dress Day Attire***

Special days are designed throughout the year by administration as “Free Dress Days”. Students are free to wear outfits of their choice; however, the following guidelines must be followed. All shirts must have a sleeve. The stomach area may not be exposed. There can be no advertisements or logos with inappropriate messages or pictures, including but not limited to any political oriented messages. Shorts must not be shorter than 3 inches above the knee from a kneeling position and dresses and skirts must not be shorter than 1 inch above the knee from a kneeling position. No tight fitting clothes. Sandals are permitted. **Due to insurance liability and fire code regulations flip-flops and “Heelys” are NEVER ALLOWED.** Caps are not permitted. Capri pants are allowed. Clothing should be modest and not tight fitting. Parents will be called to bring a complete St. Bernard School uniform if free dress day attire is inappropriate. All grooming codes continue to apply.
