Thank you for entrusting your child(ren) to us. It has been a great year thus far. I would like to take this opportunity to give you some updates on our academic programs. Here at SBS, Academics remain a top priority as we strive to be a school of excellence.

This school year marks our fourth year with PreK3 students on our campus. *Frog Street* is the curriculum of choice for PreK3. *Frog Street* PreK3 curriculum is a comprehensive language program designed to meet the needs of diverse learners. It is an interactive program that celebrates the joy of learning while children travel down the road to success. *Three Cheers* for PreK4 compliments our reading curriculum for kindergarten through third grade which is *MyView*. Grades four and five adopted *Wit and Wisdom* five years ago and grades six through eight are in their seventh year of *Wit and Wisdom* curriculum implementation. Our students in grades four through eight use *NoRedInk*, which is a writing program that give students the skills needed to communicate confidently and effectively. *HMH* continues to be our curriculum for our science classes. Our math curriculum is *enVision Math*. *enVision Math* focuses on deep conceptual math understanding aided by models, personalized learning, and 3-act tacks. We utilize several online programs to complement our curriculums (i.e. *Generation Genius*, *Mystery Science*, *IXL* and *XtraMath*).

SBS continues to implement the *Accelerated Reader (AR)* program. This summer, our incoming first graders were given the option to participate in summer reading which was a requirement for grades second through eight. Students have completed their initial *STAR* test which is used to set goals for the nine weeks. Students will take the *STAR* test each nine weeks for us to determine their reading progress and change goals as necessary. Students are given the opportunity to read independently at least fifteen to twenty minutes during the school day. They are encouraged to read during transitional times as well. Please encourage your child to read at least fifteen minutes each evening. *STAR* data is used as a baseline for identifying students requiring intervention services.

Kindergarten through third grade students are participating in a reading program called *Boost Reading* (formerly *Amplify Reading*). We have recognized a great need to increase phonics, fluency, and comprehension. *Boost Reading* is a personalized reading program that engages students in reading instruction and practice. *Boost Reading* is designed to specifically target skills students are lacking and fit every student's level and pace of learning. Data from *Boost Reading* will also be used for recommendations to our intervention program.

We use *ESGI* in PreK3 through Kindergarten to identify and address math and reading deficits. For students in first through eighth grade, we use *TerraNova* data. In addition, beginning in Kindergarten and continuing through grade seven, SBS students' academic performance is assessed annually also using *TerraNova*. *TerraNova* assessments are standardized, norm referenced tests used to provide information about students' achievement in math, reading, and language as well as provide a comparison to the performance of students in the same grade level across the nation.

Standardized achievement tests are designed to sample the skills and knowledge that students are typically expected to acquire as they progress through the grade levels. They can then serve as a basis for making inferences about overall achievement in the area(s) measured. However, no standardized test can measure all of the important outcomes of instruction in any given school or school year. The *TerraNova* assessment is one component of a comprehensive assessment program that utilizes multiple standardized, classroom, and informal assessments. Individual test scores from spring 2025 were sent home a few weeks ago.

We have four interventionists on staff that will be working in the classroom with students requiring extra assistance. Classroom "pullout" assistance is done on an as needed basis. Parents will be notified via email if their child is recommended for the intervention program. Students can enter and exit throughout the school year depending on their academic progress.

Students who have an *Academic Support Plan* on file will be re-evaluated in the next two weeks. Parents will be notified if a meeting is necessary. Teachers received student plans at the beginning of the school year.

Once again this year, *Homework Louisiana*, a free 24/7 tutoring source for kindergarten through college-age students is available to our students. *Homework Louisiana* can be accessed using the following site: <http://homeworkla.org/>. 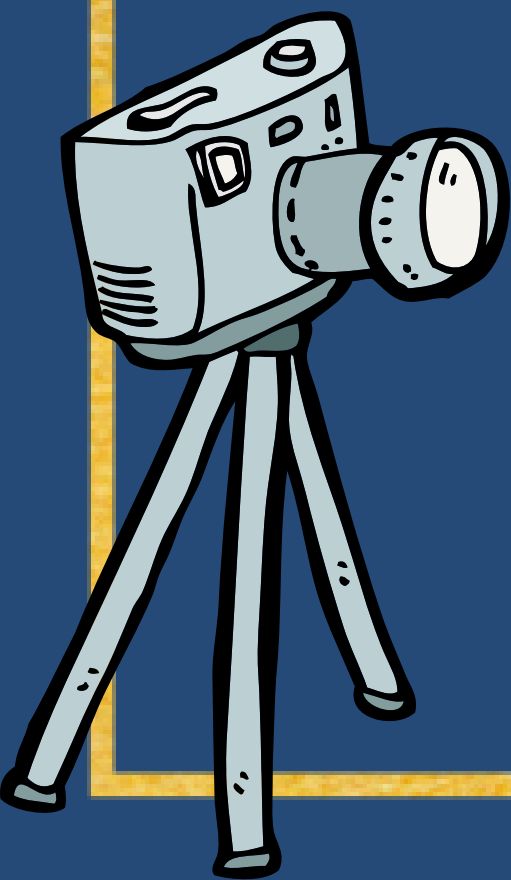

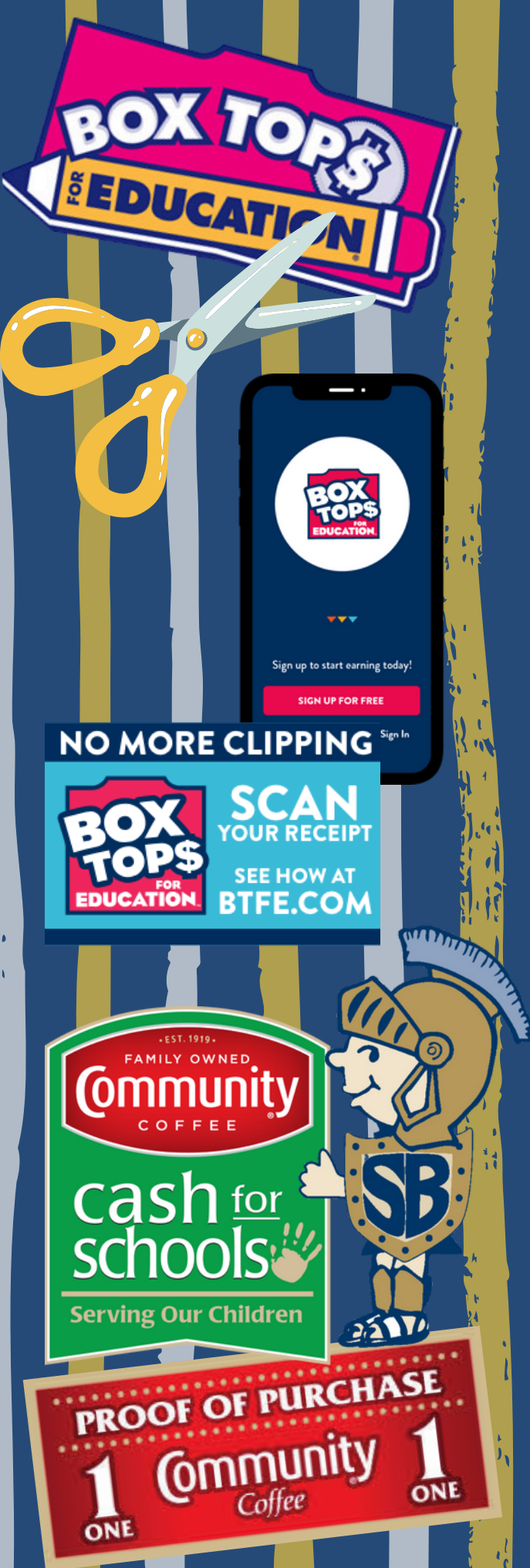

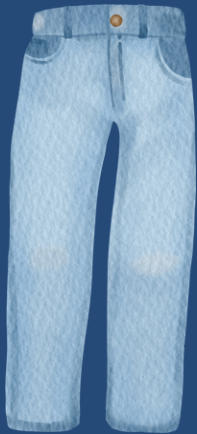
