





## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### What is the Crusader Challenge?

The Crusader Challenge is a fundraiser where friends and family donate whatever amount they choose in support of the student participating in a challenge, in our case, a race course. Donations are not determined by how fast the student completes the race or how many laps the student completes, but instead are fixed. The race is a fun way for all students to participate at a level they feel comfortable and to fundraise for school/campus improvements. There are prize incentives to encourage friendly competition among the individual students and also between classes.

### Why are we doing this school fundraiser?

The funds generated from the Crusader Challenge will be put towards campus improvements, such as future gym renovations and upgraded playground equipment, and continued curriculum development. *The funds raised this year will go towards the **replacement of the Junior High Building Roof and completion of the Gym Air Conditioning upgrade!***

### Who can participate?

All students will participate in the Crusader Challenge.

### How do you donate?

Once again this year, we are using an awesome web-based fundraising system that makes it **much easier** for you to request pledges from your family and friends, and for them to make secure credit card donations online. It's fun, it's easy, and people who use it typically raise twice as much as those who don't! Each family will create their own page using the instructions sent home on **Tuesday, October 7, 2025**. ### When will donations begin to be accepted?

### What is the deadline for donations?

Donations can be accepted all year long; however, in order for donations to count towards a student's incentive level, donations must be turned in by **Thursday, November 20, 2025, at 3:00 p.m.** Any donations turned in after this time will not be put towards a student's incentives.

## **What are the students expected to do on race day?**

On race day, students will walk, jog, or run around the Crusader Circle, a designated area, as many times as possible during a set amount of time.

## **What is the schedule of events?**

A schedule of events will be shared at a later date.

## **What if there is a chance of rain?**

The committee will keep a close eye on the forecast the week of the race. If there is a chance of rain that seems like it will affect the race, the event will be moved up to **Thursday, November 20, 2025**. Parents will be notified of the change.


## **Is there a theme for the event?**


