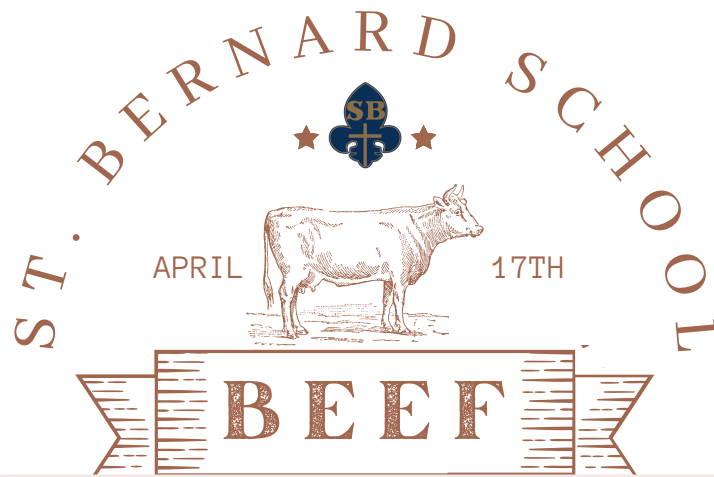

PURCHASE GIFT CARDS

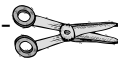
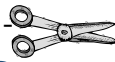
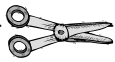

HAPPY ST. PATRICK'S DAY

Hey St. Patrick, what's up with shamrocks and all the green?!

While we celebrate with parades, festivals, dyeing rivers green, and pinching each other, we, as SBS Crusaders for Christ, know we are celebrating another great SAINT! March 17, 2026, is St. Patrick's Day, and the day celebrates the Feast Day of this Catholic Bishop from around the 5th century.

Did you know he wasn't even from Ireland?! St. Patrick was actually from the Britannia area. When he was 16, he was captured by Irish raiders and taken to Ireland to work as a slave. He finally escaped, but not before truly getting to know God and loving Him. He later became a priest and then a Catholic Bishop, and he eventually returned to Ireland to teach the people about God.

Legend has it that the shamrock was a sacred plant to the Druids, who were a revered, educated class of Irish priests, judges, teachers, and healers in ancient Celtic society. They served as the intellectual elite. St. Patrick used the three-leafed shamrock to explain the Holy Trinity - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit - to the Irish people, illustrating how three distinct entities can exist as one.

The tradition of wearing green is because Ireland, where St. Patrick preached, is called the "Emerald Isle", and green is the color of Ordinary Time in our Church calendar. It is a reminder to us that we can teach others about God and His love for us through the ordinary things we do in life!

So, on Tuesday, March 17, 2026, all students, faculty, and staff will be allowed to "accessorize" their SBS uniform with a bit of green color.
